American Kennel Club (AKC)-Largest dog recording organization in the United States.

Bitch-A female dog.

Canine Teeth-The four sharp-pointed cutting teeth.

Conformation-The form, structure, make, shape, and arrangement of the parts of the dog as they conform to the breed standard; how the dog is put together; his structure.

Crossbred-A dog whose parents represent two different breeds.

Dam-The mother of a litter of puppies.

Dock-To shorten or remove part of a dog's tail.

Gestation-The length of pregnancy, from fertilization (conception) to whelping.

Neuter-To remove the testicles in the male dog.

Pedigree-A list of a particular dog's parents, grandparents, and great grandparents (family tree).

Puppy-A dog less than a year old.

Purebred-A dog whose sire and dam belong to the same breed.

Sire-The father of a litter of puppies.

Spay-The removal of a female's reproductive organs.

Whelp-To give birth to puppies.

Name the recognized dog group breeds.

Know the external parasites and internal parasites that affect dogs.

Know diseases that affect dogs.

Name essential nutrients for your dog.

Know that gestation is normally 63 days but can range from 58-68 days.

Know about how to groom your dog and other puppy care.

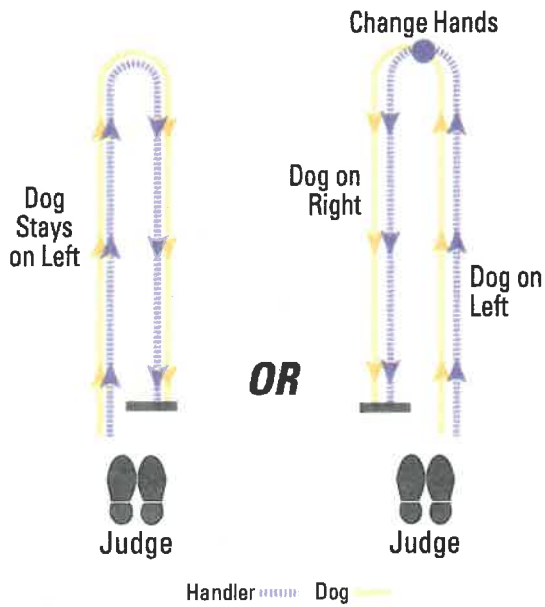
Know the normal vital signs of a dog (i.e.) temperature, heart rate, and respiratory rate.

Know the dog's senses.

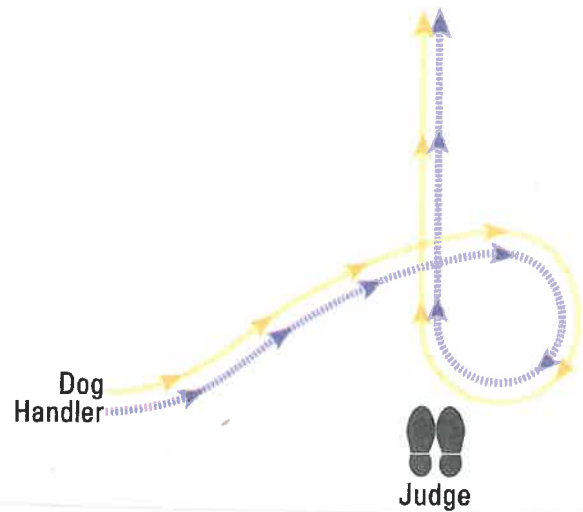
Know showmanship techniques including commands and different patterns.

Know the parts of a dog.

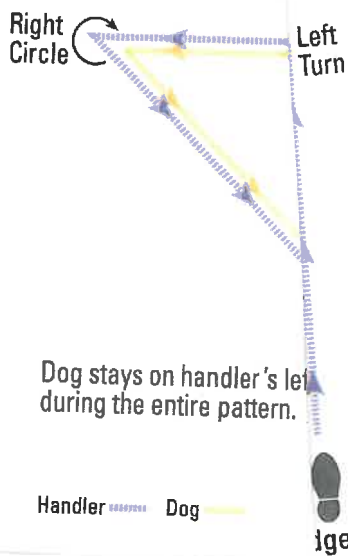
Down and Back Pattern (One Dog)



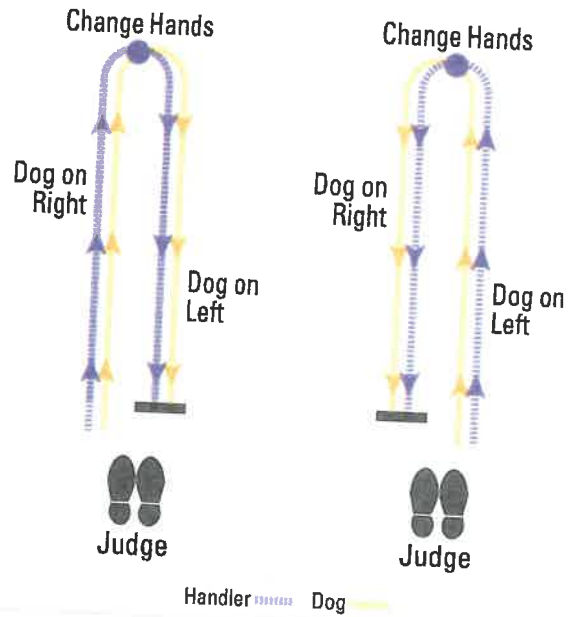
Courtesy Turn



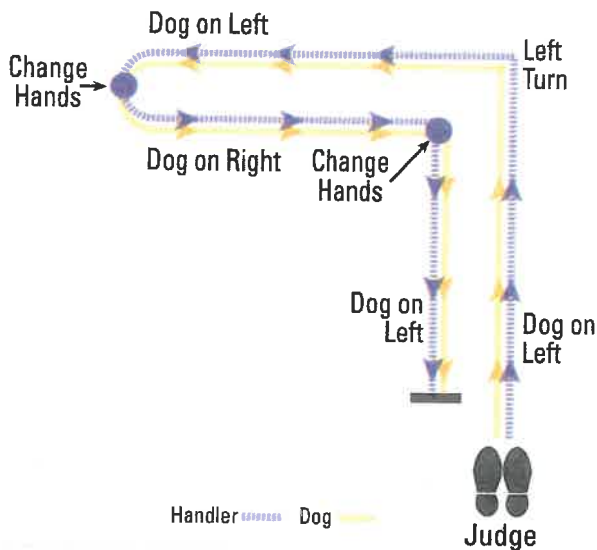
Triangle Pattern



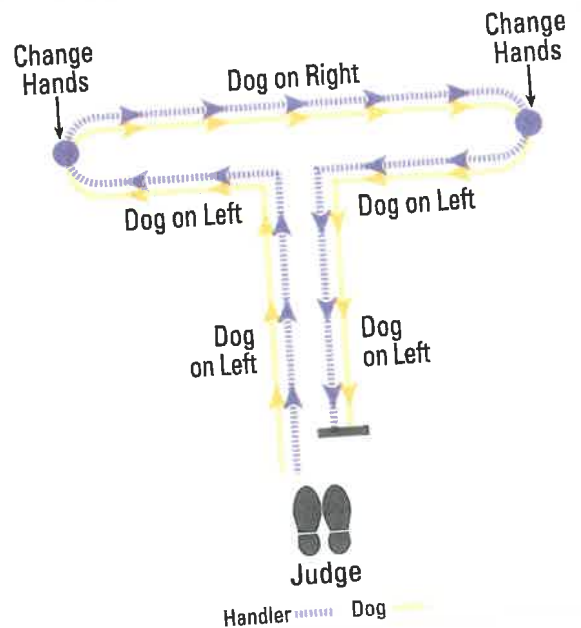
Down and Back Pattern (Two Dogs)



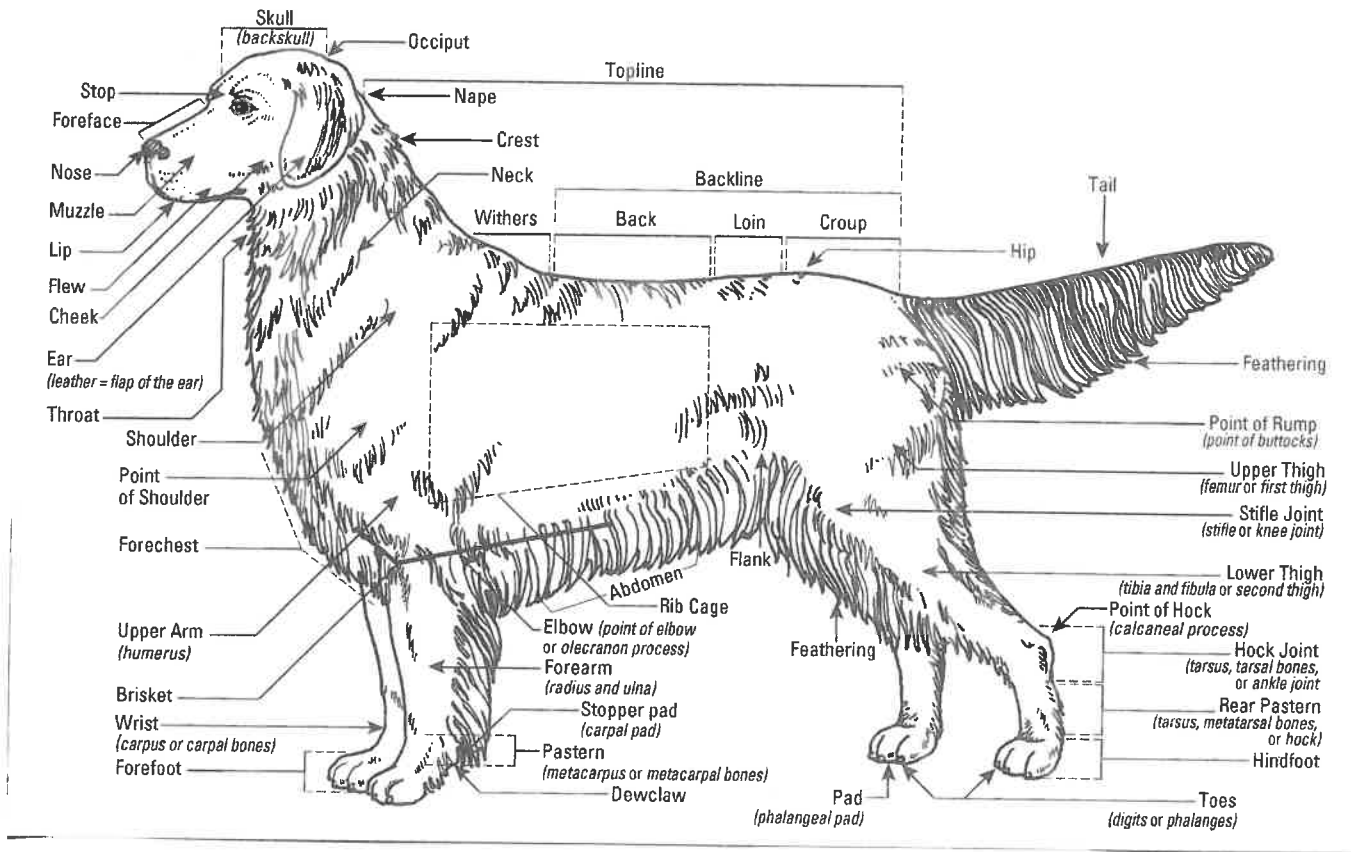
"L" Pattern
